Children's In-Home Services is an integrated approach to working with families with a child or adolescent who has a serious emotional disturbance (SED) diagnosis. Services will address mental health and substance use disorders while promoting strong and healthy family functioning, provide support to families, reunite families who have been separated, and reduce the usage and length of stay in out of home placements.

In-home services are individualized and adjusted to meet the needs of the (SED) child/adolescent and their family. To prevent out of home placement due to their behavior, emotional disturbance, substance use, mental illness and/or developmental disability services are delivered to families in their homes while maintaining and strengthening the family life.

## Services may Include:

- **Community Living Supports**
- Respite
- **Treatment Groups**
- Case Management
- Psychiatric services

Eligibility: Children and Adolescents between 4 –17 years of age living in Kent County with active Medicaid Insurance. Youth are screened for eligibility at Network 180.
