Family Outreach Center was formed in 1979 as a solution to community leaders concerns about the deterioration of family life in the 'urban core' of Grand Rapids.

Our Services

We have quality outpatient mental health, substance use disorders, education, prevention and support services for children, youth and families. We provide the support individuals and families need to be successful through all phases of life.

Our Staff

Family Outreach Center is committed to maintaining a culturally diverse and experienced staff.

The FEP represents an expansion of the substance use services available in Kent County. FEP is a family focused, community based substance use program which aims to reduce the cycle of substance use within families by treating the whole family and not just the individual with identified substance use issues. FEP addresses issues such as child care, transportation, and/or other circumstances that can present barriers to treatment.

Services include:

- Family assessment
- Treatment plan development
- Clinical care referral/coordination
- Family therapy

FEP also includes:

- Case management services designed to evaluate the basic needs of the family and to find the best way to address the needs of the family.
- **Recovery coach services** are provided by individuals with lived experience to provide support throughout recovery.

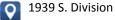
Services are provided to, to their dependent children, and identified other identified household family members

- has a substance use disorder

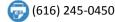
