Our Mission

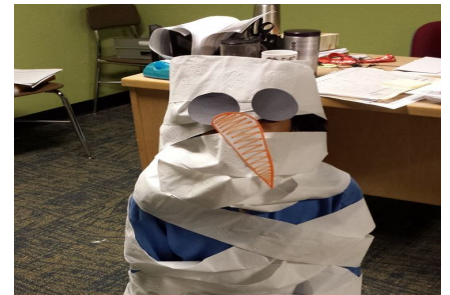
'Leading the way in promoting healthy family living by reaching out to underserved populations and those who are low-income in our community.'
